Turning Point's Core Programme

All services deliver an evidence-based core groupwork programme utilising the node link mapping approach. Delivered over a minimum 12 week period, the programme combines individual key working sessions and therapeutic group work with a range of complementary therapies, life skills sessions and community-based activities.



Turning Point Hartley House, West London

is a 12 bed drug and alcohol service in a large, friendly Victorian home which has been awarded a 3* Excellent rating by CQC. Situated in the residential area of Ealing and well served by public transport, medical facilities and shops, the project is open to post detox service users for a 3 – 6 month programme. An alternative therapy portfolio including acupuncture, massage and Reiki is available. Men and women groups are provided to residents in addition to halal food, leisure amenities and library facilities. There is also a peer mentoring programme, family support and 24-hour on call support.

Turning Point Richards House, Manchester is a 5 bed alcohol rehab service located in the north of Manchester. With a 3* Excellent CQC rating, the service provides an opportunity for individuals to complete a structured programme within a more intimate environment, with the opportunity to further benefit from complimentary therapies and extensive links with community based services in the area. The service has a vibrant ex-service user group, with regular events taking place.

Turning Point Canterbury is a residential rehabilitation project for people with alcohol misuse issues. Registered with the CQC with a history of excellence, the service can support up to 12 women and men between the ages of 18 and 65. The service programme is designed to provide a range of complementary interventions that suit the needs of each individual, the aim being to fully involve service users in all aspects of their care. For many service users the most significant and enduring aspects of their stay come from the mutual support, feedback and motivation provided by the service user group as a whole and community living is a vital part of the rehabilitation process.

Turning Point Chester offers a 10 bed drug and alcohol first stage project in Chester with close access to transport networks and easy access to the city's historic quarter. In addition, the service has a second stage 4 bed house which supports individuals' re-integration back into the community. The service provides a structured person centred programme designed to support each individual with their recovery and has been awarded a 3* Excellent rating by CQC.

Turning Point Leigh Bank, Manchester is re-opening in September 2011. Turning Point Smithfield Services, Manchester is a national drug and alcohol detox service that has been delivering inpatient detoxifications since 1993. The service is a modern and forward thinking substance misuse unit for detoxification and stabilisation.

The building consists of a 32 bed, residential substance misuse unit located in Manchester City Centre and currently treats upwards of 500 service users a year providing 24 hour nurse-led care. Smithfield accepts nationwide referrals and benefits from easy transport links to the whole of the UK.
