These are the questions that you will need to answer using the online application form. You may wish to write them in word first before copy and pasting them into the application.

1. Tell us about your project idea

- How your project meets one or more of the 5 ways to wellbeing
- How your project contributes to the local community
- How this project brings different people and communities together

2. How do you know that there is a need for your project in the local community?

- Any research you have done to make sure that this is something that local residents will be interested in engaging in.
- Are there similar projects in the local area and how you will make sure that your project is different

3. What opportunities will your project generate for the local community?

- Boosting the economy- shopping locally by using local and independent shops
- How will you ensure that your project has a positive impact on the environment
- Any volunteering opportunities for local residents

4. How will you ensure that your project reaches local residents?

- The methods that you will use to promote it
- How you will ensure that your project is inclusive and reaches diverse audiences
- Gives opportunities for service users within our Turning Point services

5. What are the objectives that your project will achieve?

- A minimum of 5 objectives that your project will aim to achieve
- Give details about how you will achieve them

6. How will you ensure that your project has a lasting legacy?

- How will your project continue beyond the Innovation fund
- Consider how your project will give people new skills or create something in the local community that will be of benefit once the project finishes.
- Tell us about any additional funding streams or ways that you can make your project self sufficient in the future.

7. How will you keep the participants of your project safe?

- How you will assess and manage any risks identified
- Whether you have/will have insurance in place to cover any accidents or incidents
- How you will keep any personal information of your participants secure
